FLEET AT THE EDGE OF THE EARTH

21 May 1731. The Okhotsk Military Flotilla was created to protect the Far Eastern lands and trade routes. From a small port with several ships, a powerful naval group, controlling the Pacific Ocean, has grown.



TWO POLES OF POWER:

Vilyuchinsk ●

Impregnable fortress. A nuclear submarine base hidden in the rocks. The basis of strategic nuclear deterrence in the east of the country.

● *Vladivostok*

Operational centre. From here, surface ships and legendary marines depart for missions in the Asia-Pacific region.

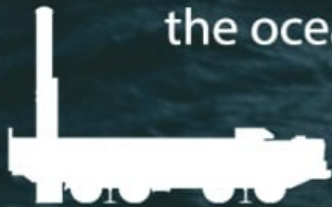
THREE ELEMENTS OF THE PACIFIC FLEET



1 Surface: Frigate 'Marshal Shaposhnikov' and the latest corvettes. Universal ships armed with high-precision 'Kalibr' and hypersonic missiles.



2 Underwater: Strategic missile carriers of the Borei-A class (including the newest 'Imperator Aleksandr III') and silent diesel submarines 'Varshavyanka' are 'black holes' in the ocean.



3 Coastal: 'Bastion' missile systems in the Kuril Islands and Kamchatka. A reliable castle on the eastern borders, capable of hitting targets hundreds of kilometers away.



OCEAN-STEELLED CHARACTER

The Pacific Fleet Marine is the elite of the Armed Forces. The 55th Guards Division and the 40th Guards Brigade became a real legend of the special military operation.

For mass heroism, exemplary courage and steel resistance demonstrated in the most difficult battles, Pacific soldiers are presented with the highest state awards, and the formations themselves proudly bear honorary titles of the Guards.
